## High Adventure Camping trips for 2007

Troop 462 is planning two exciting High Adventure Trips for this year:

1) **Fishing trip to Canada** from June 30 to July 4, 2007. We have filled our quota for 8 scouts for this trip. However, there is still room for one more scout leader. Scouts going to this camping trip must be swimmers according to the BSA regulations. Also, scouts and leaders are required to have a valid passport to be able to enter Canada.
